Plaintiffs states that on the day of ____18____, the said ROBERT BARTON departed this life interstate domicile in Knox Co., Ky. And at the Term 18__ of the Knox County Court the Plff. WM. R. BARTON and ELIZABETH TROSPER was duly and legally appointed admat. & Admrs. Of the estate of said ROBERT BARTON, dec'd. Plaintiffs states that on the day of ____18____ the said HENRY KECK departed this life interstate domiciled in Knox County, Ky., and no administration has ever been applied for or granted on said KECK estate. Plaintiff states that the said ROBERT BARTON left _____ him as his legal heirs and representative the Plaintiffs. ELIZABETH TROSPER, formerly ELIZABETH BARTON as his widow, WM.R. 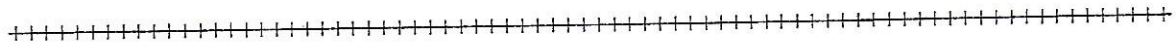
